In accordance with the WECC Progress Report Policies and Procedures, Idaho Power is pleased to submit the Boardman to Hemingway Project, Hemingway – Boardman Path, Comprehensive Progress Report.

The Boardman to Hemingway Project is a 299 mile, 500 kV transmission line from Hemingway, located in southwestern Idaho, to Boardman Power Plant 500 kV station in northeastern Oregon. The Hemingway station is the southwestern Idaho transmission hub of the Gateway West Project and will be integrated into the 230 kV transmission described in the Idaho Power Treasure Valley Electric Plan.
